- The Conference Committee will evaluate all the submitted abstracts, and authors will be notified by **February 10<sup>th</sup>**, 2023 about acceptance.
- The authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to submit at least one type of these submissions: (oral) presentation slides, poster presentation and/or video presentation before March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

## **Instructions for Authors**

• The abstract should contain: Title, Full author names, affiliation, author's email addresses, and keywords.

**Presentation sessions** will be assigned to presenters according to availability and will require the presenter to do a 10-minute presentation in PowerPoint or similar software during the symposium.

**Poster presentations** will be required to submit their final poster by February 24, additionally, a 3–5-minute video recording presenting the poster will be required. Further instructions on the creation of this video will be provided upon submission.

- Poster presentation: size B1 (70.7 x 100 cm)
- Video presentation: Video should be no longer than 3-5 minutes and prepared with the following format .mp4 (max size: 200Mb).
